

CCA General Meeting
June 15, 2010

Officers present: Paul Johnson, Susan Lee Cooke, Cathy Kolbenschlag, Rick Bradt.

The meeting commenced at 7:05 pm. Typed minutes of the May meeting were distributed to those in attendance. Kandhy Franklin-Collins made a motion that the minutes be accepted as presented. Rick Bradt seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Membership renewal letters are being received in the mail. They were mailed only to the current membership. Kandhy Franklin will send an email to the community to recruit new members and remind former members to renew their membership.

Kyle Goldberg, Boy Scout from Troup 332, will be performing his Eagle Scout project on several tasks at the the clubhouse. He will commence June 26 and welcomes volunteer assistance.

There was a discussion regarding priorities of notices on the community chalkboard.

SUB-REGIONAL PLANNING COMMITTEE: There was nothing on the agenda other than voting for the Crest seat; Kay Faris now holds that position. In May, a presentation was given regarding water lines that need to be drawn up to Crest. Kandhy was asked if a Town Hall Meeting could be scheduled in July for the purpose of giving a presentation to Crest residents. That request was approved.

CERT: Kandhy has been attending meetings in Valley Center and has learned many new ideas for the Crest CERT team. She would like to schedule a “mock emergency trial day” in September and requests support from the CCA. Approval was received.

CFSC: Kandhy reported that of the \$200,000 grant received, there was \$1,600 remaining. Therefore, she paid a liability policy to the Attorney General and fees for taxes. The goats are still in Crest and are working for the third time on one area on mustard plant. Kandhy also explained efforts she is making to work with Loren Nancarrow and Leonard Villareal on other projects. There was a lengthy discussion about CO2 chips.

JULY 4th: There was a discussion of guidelines for handwashing basins for food booths. Discussion of handicapped spaces, parade, food assignments, etc.
