

Crest Community Association General Meeting

May 19, 2009

Present: Linda Hjelle, Cathy Kolbenschlager, Glenna Evans, Susan Lee Cooke.

The meeting was opened with the flag salute.

Linda Hjelle welcomed all and encouraged residents to become members of CCA. She pointed out the benefits of being a member.

Linda asked those in attendance to look at the volunteer posters, for the 4th, and to sign up, as we need lots of volunteers this year.

A presentation was made by Crest Elementary, Dorothy Harlos and Becky Harless Grades 1 & 2/3 combination on dinosaurs.

Crest Elementary will hold a fund raiser at On the Border 5-20-09. The coupon is available online.

The Minutes were deferred.

The Treasurer's report was submitted and approved.

Linda stated we now have one year's budget in reserve and she would like to see that amount remain in the bank.

A \$500 donation was made by Crest resident, Judy Richardson to be used for the 4th. Also San Miguel Fire Dept donated \$1000. Thank you for the great support by community residents and agencies.

A discussion was held regarding all of the jobs necessary for the 4th. Linda stated there will be a meeting of all of the volunteers before the 4th.

Open Forum

- June 3rd is the scheduled CCA dinner night, but since the Kiwanis have changed their Breakfast date to the end of the month it is recommended we skip this month's dinner.
- June Music night was discussed.
- Crestridge is holding a June 6th event will be held to educate the Elementary School community on what Crestridge means to the Community. CCA has been asked to have a booth and asked for volunteers.
- June 11th Crest Elementary will host an End of School BBQ.
- Kiwanis agreed to provide a BBQ for the 4th as the primary food vendor They will fill out the food application.

- A discussion regarding the upcoming July 4th application was held General questions about why all the rules this year. Linda explained that these events have become liability issues for the county, and that's why they are requiring a permit.
- Pam Gregg asked that we consider hiring her landscapers to maintain the Club House grounds. She stated a minimum of 1/day/month would be necessary at a cost of \$75. Sally Brunner also asked, that her daughter-in-law, Laurie Brunner, be considered for the job. Kandhy Franklin asked if Pam's landscaper would also be available for minor repairs ie painting the fence, fixing lighting, etc..
- A question was asked as to how much is anticipated the Clubhouse will make vs how much the 4th will cost. Linda replied that we don't know all the answers yet, as we had to resubmit the application. They are supposed to come out this week to discuss the traffic control plan. There had also been no discussion until yesterday regarding serving food. Concern was raised that many folks were concerned and want to make sure this event continues.
- Kandhy stated that the churches are willing to open their doors so that their bathrooms may be used.
- An updated report will be prepared for the next CCA meeting and then be published in the Crest Sun.
- Kandhy stated that the student council typically comes to a board meeting to "run the meeting". They will team up with a board member. It was suggested that due to the short notice and the issues with the 4th that this be postponed till next year
- Kandhy reported that South Lane Park now has a temporary pole for lighting and a speaker system. She is waiting to hear back from the county council regarding insurance. She does not want us to pay insurance yet until she has heard back from the county regarding bathrooms, buildings, etc.
- Kandhy reported that the fuel reduction project is currently on hold due to a lawsuit which has been filed against it. Thus, the goats and handcrews are on hold until US Forestry & BLM. The Board of Supervisors are now aware of the mitigation..
